

Single Way Corps Graduate Women Marriage Parameters

In light of the lack of single Way Corps graduate men in The Way Corps household, The Way Corps leadership would like to make available the following "sanctioned exception" to the policy of active Way Corps grads marrying only active Way Corps grads.

A single woman who has been a Way Corps graduate for at least two years and is twenty-five years of age or older may get engaged to a Way Corps Alumnus or a proven Advanced Class graduate with leadership ability. The Way Corps overseers responsible for the couple must be in full agreement with the marriage, and the couple must fulfill the following guidelines:

1. The couple must be willing to go through the in-residence training program.

If not planning to have children before going in residence, the couple must be Way Corps candidates within one year of their wedding date.

If planning to have children before going in residence, the couple must be Way Corps candidates within two years of their wedding date.

2. The Way Corps graduate woman must go Way Corps Alumnus from her engagement date until the start of her candidacy year when she will take the number of the candidate Way Corps she enters. This means she will give up her Way Corps assignment in order to focus on her marriage.

The couple may take on responsibilities that are available to Advanced Class grads, for example, running a household fellowship, certain Staff positions, etc.

3. Those who avail themselves of this exceptional situation are to do so with a determined mind-set and commitment to reenter The Way Corps training.
4. If these parameters are not upheld or if the engagement is broken, The Way Corps Alumnus woman would retain her Way Corps Alumni classification as opposed to regaining her active Way Corps classification.

This is for single Way Corps graduate women; it is not available to the single men. This policy will be reconsidered yearly according to the ratio of single Way Corps graduate women to men.
